Always Hope

Readers:

My soul is so fired up today, August 4, 2020 because I know that nobody can take away my freedom or the freedom of any child of God. In some places, COVID-19 has pretty much disappeared, and the countries are declaring joyful celebrations. In other places, like the USA, we're coming out of it. In other places, they are in the middle of it. Whatever current circumstances or situations you find yourself in, you can stand with King David, Paul, Silas, and other heroes of the faith, who were delivered out of trials by God Himself.

Though it is impossible to be certain and yet very possible, King David wrote *Psalm 7, 27, 31*, and *34* while he was running and fleeing Saul's wrath although one commentary suggests that part of *Psalm 27* was while he was running away from Doeg, the Edomite specifically. Regardless David wrote these Psalms while he was not a free man. In other words, he was a fugitive on the run, and yet David had freedom because he was a child of the Living God.

The point is that in all of this David was free in the spirit. The Spirit of God manifested Himself in David's life even though David was fleeing for his life because the Spirit of the Lord resided in David, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. We see this also in the New Testament with Paul and Silas, "Who, having received such a charge, thrust them into the inner prison, and made their feet fast in the stocks. And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them. And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed," (Acts 16:24-26 KJV). Paul and Silas were literally in jail, and in those days, the prisons were not like they are today. There were no comforts at all. Their feet were in stocks. That means they couldn't walk at all. It would be impossible to walk or even effectively move. Yet, they raised their voices to Heaven and worshipped God, giving Him thanks, right in front of the other prisoners. They didn't care who saw them, who heard them, or what their

singing sounded like. They simply showed their devotion to God by singing and praising Him. The Lord heard their cry and showed up in the middle of the night, performing a miracle. God caused a great earthquake to shake the foundations of the prison to the point where the shackles of all the prisoners were loosened and all the jail cell doors opened wide.

If anything this pandemic has taught us (there's many, many lessons), the lesson I am discussing today is that nobody can take away our worship to the Lord Jesus Christ. Nobody can shut our mouth or chain our tongue, or bind and tie them. The Spirit



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of the Living God who lives in us has given us the freedom to worship, praise, adore, shout, sing, or make a joyful noise unto Him. It appears the church was under siege. While the church was shut off, places like clubs, bars, liquor stores, and medical marijuana shops were open. Somehow COVID-19 was an issue for churches. Let me give you some examples. My daughter's birthday was June 8. I planned a parade of cars to drive by my home. They were all family members, and they got out of their car, stood at the social distancing rule, family with family, and that was a problem for the spectators that came by. It was celebration that lasted five minutes, obeying legal guidelines. Yet a few days later, riots were breaking out. Thousands of people

went through various cities around the USA smashing private properties, screaming, yelling, swearing, getting up in people's faces, hurting other people, some killed during the riots, and yet the freedom to worship in church was considered loving your grandparents. I have no problem with protesting. In fact, that is a legal freedom that this country can never lose. What I cannot stand for is destruction of property, destroying other people's businesses, hurting other people, and killing others. Yet no one had a problem with the government allowing

the COVID-19 to spread. This is called the Church Being Under Siege and Attacked.

What should the church do? The Church needs to legally fight back. You do it with petitions, by seeking to have laws changed, protecting the laws already in place such as freedom of speech and freedom of religion. This means that if riots are allowed, church services should be allowed. This means if the liquor stores are going to be opened so people can get drunk, then the church should be opened for people to take communion for them to remember what Christ did on Calvary and for them to be healed. Just as some go to get their marijuana or alcohol to numb their pain or illness, then the church should be open for people to have their spiritual needs met.

Unfortunately, some within the body of believers are Christian in name only and are not actually living the life of Christian. In February, God started to reveal prophetic words and visions. I didn't understand what God was saying at that time. It was just too overwhelming. I took what God was saying to me, and I shared it with those who hold my ministerial credentials, my closest friends, and Thread of Hope Board Members. What God was showing me was scary but filled with hope. He was telling me what He was going to do and how He was going to solve it. Here is one of the words He gave me: "I am allowing COVID-19 to suit My purposes. I am separating the sheep from the goats. I am coming back, and I am coming back for a church

without spot or wrinkle. I cannot look the other way. Shepherds are leading sheep to slaughter. I can no longer allow this to happen. I am shutting churches down and removina shepherds from the pulpits." I didn't understand what God was telling me in the middle of March until a week later or so when the President of the USA, President Donald J. Trump, declared a nationwide emergency, and everybody needed to shut down including churches. In the month of May, the President declared that

churches could reopen following strict guidelines, and yet many Pentecostal Holy Spirit filled churches, as of the first week of August, continued to remain closed. I'm not judging anyone. All I know is that workplaces, supermarkets, coffee places, restaurants, beaches, parks, etc. are all open, but some churches still remain closed. Why is that? Because God gave me a word in the middle of March telling me what was to happen, how it was going to happen, why it was going to happen, what was His purpose was, and what would be His outcome. In that specific word, I have seen with my own eyes and heard with my own ears so far what took place.

To the Remnant: You understand in the spiritual realm what is happening. To those who proclaim

to be Christians and are under fear, I understand your fear. However, greater is He that is in us than He that is in the world. To live is Christ, to die is gain. Psalms 91 is clear. I encourage you to read it. This Psalm 91 is for any believer who abides under the shadow of the Almighty. No harm shall befall you. Thousands will fall to your left and ten thousands to your right. The deadly pestilence will not come near your dwelling place. Do you get the point here? Whom shall we be afraid of? Those whom the Lord loves are under His care and protection. Please understand clearly. I am not telling you to be careless and go against medical advice, but when you see that it does not apply to everyone else, then it should not apply to the Church either. This is what I am sharing with you.

Being careful is one thing. Being fearful is another. The suicide rate has skyrocketed. Just ask any pediatrician and you can ask and hear how many children are depressed, worried, and anxious. How can this be when the Word of God says that those He has set free are free indeed?

Do you remember in February when the Italians went on their balcony, building after building, and they began to sing and rejoice, not allowing themselves to be broken? This is the reason the Church needs to come together because there is power in unity. When the Church comes together, there is a rising of hope and strength as they worship together. Their faith rises as they hear the Word of God being preached. Your mind is renewed, and you are filled with the Spirit of the Living God. You are full in the Spirit. When you are filled with the spirit, you are set free.

AN INTERVIEW WITH REV. DR. TERESA ALLISSA CITRO

It has been guite a year! 2020 came in like any other year, and then COVID-19 struck. National lockdown went into place, and states ended up with mandatory lockdowns and legal guidelines as to how to proceed during the pandemic. The COVID situation was serious and hitting some nations harder than others. Many people have been frightened, panic-stricken, not knowing what to do, and faced with the emotional stress and anxieties their own children were and still are dealing with. When talking with Rev. Dr. Teresa Citro, she told EL Staff the one thing she was clutching onto that has been her strong refuge and place of safety. In talking with her, you could sense her hope through all of the craziness of COVID. She shared with us the determination in keeping what she learned through this pandemic isolation and the excitement she holds for the upcoming months and the future.

Linda: It seems everyone was taken by surprise by the year 2020. Where things were going in normal routine, children in school, adults working, and people going on about their lives. What were your expectations coming into the New Year and have those expectations changed given the events of this year?

Dr. Citro: No, my expectations have not changed,

and let me explain why. At the end of 2019, God gave me two bible verses that were my personal bible verses for the year 2020. The first Bible verse was Isaiah 55:12(KJV), "For ye shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands." second verse was Jeremiah 31:4(KJV), "Again I will build thee, and thou shalt be built, O virgin of Israel: thou shalt again be adorned with thy tabrets, and shalt go forth in the dances of them that

make merry." As you know, Linda, I called you to tell you that God had given me those Bible verses for 2020. I know how the year is going to end. I knew how the year 2020 would end, but I just didn't know what the beginning or the middle of it would look like. However, we serve the Living God who does not leave us hopeless but leaves us hopeful in the midst of the crisis. In the midst of any disaster, God gives us word of encouragement to uplift us so we can hang onto the words He has given us.

Linda: Yes, I remember phone call about the bible verses, and I also remember another phone call,

> in early January, where you were very upset because God showed what would happen this coming year. I know this is painful, but could you share that story

with us?

Dr. Citro: Oh, Linda, if I could just go back in time... It was during my quiet time with the Lord. God seems to reveal a lot when we spend quality time with Him. God is so loving and so good. compassion fails. His love for us is truly enormous, and because of that love and compassion, He prepares us for things that are going to happen.

This is the ultimate intimacy with the Lord Jesus Christ. Out of the blue, while I was praying, the Holy Spirit dropped a painful situation that was about to occur in my family. He told me that this year He was going to call my father home.

His love for us is truly enormous, and because of that love and compassion, He prepares us for things that are going to happen. As you know, I called you immediately and was crying on the phone. I couldn't understand how I going to go out shouting and dancing with tambourines and how that was going to happen with the death of my father. It stunned me. There's nothing joyful about losing someone you love, but God's word to me was to prepare myself and to prepare the children. I told my children what God had told me. I told them to spend a lot of time with their grandfather and treasure him because Jesus would be taking him home. My children grieved and mourned before my father was suddenly taken from us. Imagine my shock when three months later what God told me took place. I know that many people around the world have lost loved ones this way. I want you to know I feel your pain, and I understand your tears. Grief is real, but we don't stop at the grief. The best way to move on from grief is to live your life the way God would have you to live it with joy, honor, and continue the journey towards your destiny. It doesn't mean you stop loving the person you lost. It doesn't mean you will no longer miss them. It doesn't mean you don't remember the good times. It simply means that all those things are a part of who you are. You can't just forget good memories. You can't just say you no longer love someone. It doesn't mean one moment you forget. It just means that all those things made you who you are. We honor the ones we love by not allowing ourselves to remain in a mourning state. This is what I had to learn. God is there in our grief. The Holy Spirit whispers comfort and peace. Jesus is holding us in His embrace.

Linda: Not all lessons are easy to learn, and those were some really tough lessons. However, trials and problems shape our character and nature, and it is also in those hard times, we end up learning about the nature and character of God the most. There was something else you had shared with the board and myself back in February. Can you please share that with us?

Dr. Citro: Again, Linda, when God began speaking to me in early February, about what was to come and ended up sharing that with you and the board at Thread of Hope. You gave me two Bible verses at the beginning of the year, but the complete opposite is happening right now. God had called Thread of Hope and me to pray for one hour a day regarding this new virus that had not even entered the USA yet. The first phase of the prayer for several weeks was to rebuke, and

then God started to give me visions and words. As you know, I couldn't believe, Linda, what God was revealing to me. He showed me what was going to happen, what would be said, and what the real truth was. A complete spirit of confusion was about to hit our land and the world, and God was allowing it for one purpose: for the greatest revival that is about to hit the world. I'm not ready to say more about this at this particular time. However, I would ask the Church who is the Remnant to please stand up and align yourself on the side of righteousness. Do not allow yourself to be fooled. Do not be filled with fear and trembling, and do not allow yourself to be deceived. What we see, hear, and read is the total opposite of what is really happening. I know this year is going to end with dancing and shouting in the streets. This is why the Holy Spirit gave us this phrase "Set Free" for this issue.

Linda: Normalcy was suddenly stripped from society as a whole affecting the smallest individual to the oldest. Freedoms seemed stripped away as many couldn't work because businesses had to be shut down. Some lost their jobs completely. Many have had to experience loneliness and isolation from family and friends because of being in lockdown and federal and state guidelines for dealing with the whirlwind effects of COVID-19. Celebrations of special events such as graduations, weddings, birthdays, the list goes on had to be canceled. How have you dealt with the COVID-19 pandemic?

Dr. Citro: I don't really want to make this all about my father's death. However, in the middle of this pandemic, my father, unfortunately, had passed away. That meant we couldn't hold a funeral. Only ten people were allowed, and no church service. Between my brothers, my mother, and me, we were 14 people. So you can imagine the heartbreak of four people who were unable to go. However, Linda, God is good to His people, and He does give us our heart's desire. I saw the kindness of people and their compassion and love all around me popping up all around me. The funeral home, DeVito's Funeral Home, was amazing. My two children and two of my father's other grandchildren could say their final goodbyes to my father. DeVito's drove my father's body to our home and opened the casket in the backyard. Each family member, practicing social distancing, was able to say our goodbyes properly. You know, Linda, we're a family. We

had the right to mourn as a family and not be isolated and to send him properly into his eternal rest. We, as a family, were deeply moved by this gesture of kindness and compassion. They conducted themselves with honor and respect towards my father's body. It is forever etched in our minds that moment in time because we actually felt their love. The COVID-19 showed me the best and the worst of people. So, I don't know how no one's life can be the same after COVID-19. I kept myself and my family busy. The first six weeks was a little easier, but because of my father's death that was overly emotional, and we were grieving as a family and couldn't get together. I found things to do with my children such as taking them on rides, family movies, cooking special foods, planting a garden, and making plans of future vacations to keep us going. As you know, Linda, I buried myself in work. We wrote three books. So, even though we were locked up, I felt that my children and I would make the best of the situation, rekindled old friendships. spent a lot more time in prayer, and I spent a lot of time on the phone ministering to people who were hurting and felt hopeless, reminding them that God was going to heal our land, and that we would come out of it as better people. During this lockdown, I discovered my 14-year old daughter has an incredible gift for drawing as you have seen, Linda. I've decided to showcase the picture because she drew us as a family because sometimes when we have nothing else to do, it's a time for us to discover new abilities, talents, and giftings. This got birthed out of her staying home. She also taught herself guitar, and as you know, Linda, she has an incredible voice. She spent time singing.

Linda: I've known you for too long not to know that you are going somewhere with this. May I ask where you are going with this?

Dr. Citro: (she laughs at my question because she knows I know her too well) Linda, what does Philippians 6:4-7? It says, "Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus." Linda, the Apostle Paul wrote that letter while sitting in a jail cell. Isn't this what everyone around the world had to do while being in lockdown? Paul faced physical abuse. He was persecuted for his faith. He had a chronic ailment. He suffered financial hardship, and he was alone. Aren't these things the same things everyone around the world has been faced with this year? How many lost their jobs and their financial security? How many people were dealing with cancer and other deadly diseases and found their treatment had to stop? How many children and women were faced with physical abuse because

everything shut down? Lastly, wasn't the church persecuted? Never before in the 21st Century has the church been persecuted like it has been during COVID-19. We can certainly identify ourselves with the Apostle Paul. God knew that, and this Scripture says it all.

Linda: I agree with you that the church was persecuted. I don't think anyone would have thought of churches in the USA shutting down due to COVID while liquor stores and bars were still open.

Dr. Citro: And many churches are still closed months after we were told that we could go. Restaurants are opened. Why can't pastors open their churches?

Linda: I think it's safe for me to assume that somehow Philippians 4:6-7 comes into play with not only what you just asked about pastors opening up their places of worship but also in addressing the Body of Christ as a whole.

Dr. Citro: Linda, you know me way too well. (she was laughing but then her tone became serious) This bible verse strikes me in so many ways. The Apostle Paul wasn't suggesting in any way, fashion, form, or shape that everything is fine. He understood fear induces anxiety, which is what the whole world has experienced, but right there the first thing he says is not to worry about

anything. Don't be anxious. Fear brings worry, and worry brings anxiety. We are commanded to worry. There are only three ways to guarantee to be free of anxiety, and that is to pray, petition God, and with thanksgiving let God know how you feel. When we seriously put into exercise these things then the peace of God guards our heart and mind in Him because it transcends all understanding. We do not have figure everything out. It doesn't make sense to our mortal mind. However, we have exercised that which is proper and right, and in doing so, our own hearts and minds are steadfast in Jesus Christ. It doesn't mean we are not going to feel fear or anxiety, but we have been given the tools for beating and overcoming it all beautifully wrapped in this bible verse, "Dear Friends, do not anxious about anything." That is my message.

And there you have it, Folks! You, as part of the Remnant, have been set free because the Son of God, Jesus Christ, has set you free! Whom the Son has set free is free indeed! The God you serve never slumber nor sleeps. Therefore, because God keeps His eyes on you, you do not need to worry nor be anxious about anything. The God who cares for the birds of the air and the lilies of the field is the same God who supplies all your needs according to His riches in glory. Against All Odds

In these troublesome times in which we find ourselves there is a faith in our Covenant God who supersedes any and every circumstance of life.

In the Old Testament book of Judges chapters 6 and 7, there is a great story of a man named Gideon and a small army of 300 Israelites that God used to defeat their enemy the Midianites (meaning, "strife" or "contention" There is much "strife" in families, many Churches, America and among Nations.) who were also distant relatives through Father Abraham.

Because Israel had done evil in the Lord's sight He allowed them to be oppressed by the Midianites for seven years. (7 in the Bible always equates to the completion of something). The Midianites were so cruel that the Israelites made hiding places in the mountains, caves and special forts.

Their enemies would attack and destroy Israel's crops leaving them with nothing to eat. If that wasn't enough, they would take all of the sheep, goats, cattle and donkeys. The land was stripped bare and the Israelites were defenseless and defeated. In their starved and depressed condition, they cried out to the Lord for help, and He answered through a prophet.

Before the Lord can deliver His people from their trouble, He FIRST must point out to them the reason for their trouble. God declared to Israel; "I am the Lord your God. You must not worship the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you now live. But you have not listened to me."

Disobedience and backsliding were the roots of Israel's problem, and I believe it is much the same with America.

"For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?" (1 Peter 4:17)

Paul instructed his son in the Gospel in his second letter to Timothy; "that in the last days there will be very difficult times." He then gave Timothy a description and list of the spirit and condition of people's attitudes in these days (Includes America):

- 1. "People will love only themselves and their money."
- 2. "They will be boastful and proud, scoffing at God."
- 3. "Disobedient to their parents and ungrateful."
- 4. "They will consider nothing sacred."
- 5. "They will be unloving and unforgiving."
- 6. "They will slander others and have no self-control."
- 7. "They will be cruel and hate what is good."
- 8. "They will betray their friends, be reckless, be puffed up with pride, and love pleasure rather than God."
- 9. "They will act religious, but they will reject the power that could make them godly.

Our history parallels Israel's because of our Judeo-Christian foundation.

America has had their share of "pillow prophets" that tickle the listener's ears (2 Timothy 4:3). but true prophets are standing up and standing out calling for repentance and it must begin with God's people the Church.

The SECOND thing God does is find a man that will lead his people in obedience to His instructions. A righteous judge if you please. Gideon was that man. God told him, "Go with the strength you have, and rescue Israel from the Midianites, I am sending you."

Gideon had his misgivings about why Israel was in their present oppressive condition and his low status in his clan, tribe and family that he should be chosen of God to be used. Just like Gideon, many of God's people feel unqualified to be used of God to do anything great. An Inferiority complex handicaps many people, and only the Word of the Lord can break that spirit.

The Word says, "For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called: But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things

which are mighty; And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: That no flesh should glory in his presence," (1 Corinthians 1:26-29).

Gideon's name means; feller (to fell a tree), Great Warrior, and generally to destroy anything or cut asunder. God knew that Gideon was the man to cut down the Midianites, but Gideon had such an inferiority complex that he needed a sign from God to affirm his calling. (Judges 6:17-24)

Our Omniscient God knows what you are capable of accomplishing through faith and obedience and all He's looking for is your availability. Don't

let anything in your past or present disqualify you from your Divine Destiny. When you invite Jesus the superior one into your life, He destroys an inferiority complex.

Will You Be That Man or Woman?

The THIRD thing God does is test Gideon personally with an instruction to obedience as He will test all of us.

Pull down your father's altar to the false god Baal. (Baal represents a false god who was thought by the Canaanites to bless their fields and crops as farmers. When Israel came into the land they were shepherds and herdsman and learned to farm and were lead to believe that Baal and their God Jehovah together would bless their endeavors.)

"In its place build an altar to God and bring in your offerings of restoration there," (Judges 6:25-32).

America has built many false gods that have replaced the Altar of the God of the Bible.

Will you; like Gideon; pull down the altars to the false gods of your father?

The bottom line is that America has brought their offerings and laid them at the altars of false gods. (Worldly lusts and ungodliness) "Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world;" (Titu 2:12 KJV).

America has allowed the people of other nations to bring their gods and practices into America and have allowed those false gods to be placed on the same level as Jehovah God thinking all gods lead to salvation.

"Thou shalt have no other gods before me," (Exodus 20:3 KJV).

"I am the Lord, and there is none else, there is no God beside me: I girded thee, though thou hast not known me," (Isaiah 45:5 KJV; 44:6, 8).

When we restore God's altar and bring our offerings to His altar, then we qualify for victory over our enemy.

The FOURTH thing God does is to possess his righteous and obedient judge Gideon with His Holy Spirit (Judges 6:34).

The problem in many denominational churches of America today is that many have replaced the Holy Spirit of God with man's religious education.

Just as Adam was instructed not to eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, (Genesis 2:17, a tree of education). Education has its place but not at the expense of the Omniscient Teacher, The Holy Spirit of God.

No person, whether Old Testament or New Testament, can conquer any enemy without the power of the indwelling Holy Spirit of God (Acts 1:8; Matthew 12:28).

After the initial call of God, dealing with an inferiority complex, excuses, the test of obedience, being possessed by the very Spirit of God, and Gideon's testing God, there comes a point in time that our faith must become action.

1)THE FEARFUL & FAITHLESS ARE DISMISSED (Judges 7:2-3)

For those who believe the old adage; "there's strength in numbers" really do not know how God works.

The Midianite army numbered 135,000 while the

Israelite army only numbered 32,000. The odds are at a little over 4 to 1. As far as the facts of mathematics go, it's not looking good for Israel. If that's not discouraging enough to the soul of Gideon, God tells him he has too many men. What?!

God tells Gideon to tell the men that if any man is timid or afraid to go home! Twenty Two Thousand (22,000) Israelite soldiers went home because they were shuddering and trembling with terrorizing fear. That was a majority of the men in the Israelite army.

"There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love,"

(1 John 4:18 KJV).

The Bible says, "There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love," (1 John 4:18 KJV).

Twenty Two Thousand (22,000) men weren't confident that God loved them enough to help them defeat their enemy that outnumbered them 4 plus to 1.

Their faith was weak because the Midianites had been permitted to oppress them for 7 long years and now each man has done the math and knows he has to kill 4-5 of them to win. No Way!!!

The Facts of your life will always intimidate your soul and try to send you home (mind, emotions and will).

During the release of covid19, I've witnessed much of the Church who are God's people act

like the 22,000 Israelite soldiers that refused to fight because of fear.

Many even used scripture to defend their "cautious" position and putting man's wisdom above God's wisdom and power. Caution is just a precursor to Fear.

On August 29th, 2017 in the emergency room, God gave me a life-changing testimony. The doctor's news that night flooded my heart with despair. I was diagnosed with end-stage liver cirrhosis. The doctor said unless I get a transplant, I would die a slow and painful death - All of my organs would slowly shut down one by one." She asked me if I wanted to speak with a priest or a pastor. I had no idea I would fight to stay alive for the next 16 months.

The surprising thing about this disease is you may be sick for decades and not even know it. It doesn't matter how old you are, if you eat a healthy diet, exercise on a regular basis, or don't drink alcohol, some diseases, such as cirrhosis, can take up to 10 years before they emerge. By the time you begin to experience some of the symptoms, the disease has already begun to wreak havoc in your body. One day you are feeling well and the next day you are suddenly diagnosed with a life-threatening condition, and your world is turned upside down.

I was desperate and exhausted from the ascites and carrying up to 19 pounds of bodily fluid every week. I had to be drained on a weekly basis to reduce the pressure on my body and ongoing threat to my life. I felt chained to the hospital and would be there for several hours as complications would arise. This process went on week after week and then worsened. The procedures got so bad the nurses and technicians were having a difficult time getting my body to accept catheters of all sizes.

When the technicians finally got a catheter in, they were not able to remove the water from my body. I was informed my peritoneum was scarred from all the paracentesis procedures. My body had reached its limits. I was seen by many doctors and specialists from Georgia to New Mexico and ran out of guarantees. No doctor could explain the root cause and referred to the condition as "idiopathic cirrhosis" meaning unknown origin.

If you had told me that one day I would be standing and sharing my testimony at churches, I would not

have believed it. Especially, when there appeared to be no end in sight to all the procedures I had to undergo (over 35 paracentesis). After resisting a TIPS procedure (where they insert a stent into the liver) I had to trust in God and view laying down my body on the table as an act of worship to Him.

I wanted God to heal me on my terms and not His will. I struggled to let go of control of how I wanted God to heal me. While I waited for my physical healing, He touched me and healed more than I could have imagined. He began to heal my soul (mind, will, and emotions). He began to touch my family. Faith was increased. He comforted me

in my suffering. God delivered me in the name of Jesus. He prepares our beds and restores us back from sickness.

I'm pressing into Him more than ever. I need Him. He is my everything! He desires diligence in faith from us. The blood of Jesus can wash away your sins. The power of the Cross gives you power over every sin. The Kingdom of Heaven resides within you. We are co-heirs with our Lord Jesus. We want to walk in full health, but God's will is greater than that, He wants us to be yielded vessels that give thanks to Him in everything, rejoicing always, and praying without ceasing. We can walk in full health and in wholeness.

The decade of the 1960's was known for many social movements, black power, women's liberation, flower power are just a few. However, one of the bigger movements amongst the youth was freedom. They believed parents, government, business and education all were a form of bondage, pushing them to be the same, think the same, conform. The music of the 1960's expressed this theme: "People Gotta Be Free", "Freedom", and "Me and Bobby McGee". What this desire for freedom conveyed was something more than deliverance from external restraints!

Fast forward to 2020 and will still see this same desire for freedom, but it has taken a more radical, dangerous direction. Now. in their zeal for freedom to be what they want and do what they want, militant groups are intimidating and shaming people in their guest to be free. Think about it, in their desire to be without restraints they are attempting to place others in bondage. How did this

go so wrong? What happened to "peace and love"? What are you and I, the redeemed of the Lord, to do?

Still, even though we were born into Adam's race the blessed truth is . . . we don't need to stay there! Remember I said we walk by faith? Faith sees the spirit realm. Faith comes from knowing God's will and God's way. Faith comes from meditating on His revealed Word. 

Free at Last...Really?

We're hearing a lot about freedom these days... mostly from people who don't realize they're already free.

When Jesus said, "You shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free," He was talking about Himself! Remember, He IS the Truth! More often than not, however, this scripture is misquoted when people say, "The truth will SET you free." There's a huge difference between being SET free and being MADE free:

- To be SET free means that your bondage (like a locked cell door in a jail) has been released.
 You can now go out or stay in because the door is unlocked. You've been set free.
- To be MADE free means that even if the cell door is still closed and locked, who you are within yourself is free. To "make" something means to create it; you are a new creature in Christ Jesus, wonderfully and fearfully made...and free! Free no matter who you are. Free no matter where you are. Free no matter what anyone else says or does.

How does He make us free?

The above scripture from John 8:32 is actually self-explanatory. Jesus tells us that knowing the truth is what makes us free. So, let's look at that a little bit. In John 17:3 Jesus said this to His disciples (don't forget, you're a disciple, too):

"And this is life eternal, that they may know You the only true God and Jesus Christ, whom You have sent."

That's pretty awesome in and of itself, but it's really verse 2 that has the power:

"As You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him."

There is absolutely nothing that we can do to earn our freedom. Jesus paid the price—the penalty—that we were supposed to pay because of our sins. He didn't just go to jail; He went to the cross and died for us. We didn't have to do anything. He did it all...for all people, all sin, for all time. Think about this: every person who dies, leaves this earth with their sins forgiven. Does

that mean they all go to be with the Lord? Sadly, that's not what it means. Jesus forgave our sins, but we have to believe in Him and accept what He did, repent for our sins, and then receive our forgiveness from Him by faith.

Not every act of rebellion looks like chaos or temper tantrums or evil. Rebellion is subtle and can slip into a person's life very quickly

and bring spiritual death with it. There are a lot of people who are doing "good" things based on their own definition of good. These days especially, people have a form of godliness but do not have the actual power of the Living God within them. They look good, they sound good, they do good. Rebellion is often shrouded in the appearance of good. However, in the book of Genesis, the Lord's only rule for Adam and Eve was that they do not eat from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. It's not that He didn't want them to know the difference between good and evil, it's just that He wanted everything they knew and everything they did to be based on His word and His will. It's the same today.

In our society, we don't hesitate to do our own thing. Most people seldom refer to God before they get dressed in the morning or when they go out for the day; and they certainly don't trouble the Lord about what they eat, or how much money they spend. That may not sound like rebellion to you, but it is.

We need to repent. We need to seek God's will in everything we do.

But how do we actually live in His freedom?

Easy. Re-read the sentence above: Repent. Seek God's will. That, Dear Reader, is the only way to truly live in freedom and truly enjoy the peace that freedom brings.

Now let's clarify something before we go any further. We are not talking about living "under the law." That's a really popular term among church-goers who don't want to obey God. Helping Students with Learning Disabilities Amid Pandemic

The COVID-19 epidemic has impacted special education service delivery in the United States and beyond. When schools shut down for the COVID-19, the country was unprepared for this situation as learning shifted to virtual learning.

The pandemic's fallout is likely to be severe and long-lasting. Early reports suggest that students may re-enter school in the fall of 2020 almost a full year behind academically. The pandemic's timing was especially worrisome since it coincided with the summer slide when the loss of learning occurred for most students. This loss will disproportionately affect some student populations, including those from low-income households, those who lack access to online learning technologies, and those whose parents have a non-standard work schedule that limits their ability to participate in homeschooling. DCF reports also indicated that students in volatile home environments faced extreme hardships as most of their safety nets were removed. Please refer to my article on "maintaining the momentum" to learn what parents can do to minimize the summer slump.

Most students with disabilities in the US operate under an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) as specified by the IDEA. There is strict adherence to the contents of the IEP, and there were no provisions in the IEP that accounted for emergencies like that of the COVID-19 situation. School districts scrambled for support and guidance from the top educational department in their various states.

Previously, there were no legal mandates for whether a school was required to continue providing such services to students with disabilities in the case of extended school closures due to exceptional circumstances.

Most states encouraged public agencies and school departments to work with parents to reach a mutually agreeable extension of timelines related to children with disabilities. It was also recommended that the district and parent agree to amend IEPS without convening a PPT meeting when appropriate.

Almost all schools in the US shifted to remote learning during the pandemic.

The consensus was that students with a learning disability would struggle with virtual learning due to the teacher's inability to make accommodations remotely. Most teachers provide accommodations and modifications for students with disabilities, as specified in the IEP. There were no such provisions for remote learning in the IEP for teachers to follow.


A survey of 147 students with and without disabilities was collected in late March to early April of 2020 to assess the impact of COVID-19 on students' education and mental health. Findings show that students with disabilities/ health concerns were more concerned about classes going online than their peers without disabilities. These concerns were legitimate. For example, students with motor neuron disease but have visual acuity, pop-ups, and overlays can make web browsing problematic. For those with photosensitive epilepsy, flashing lights or images may cause seizures. However, some experts posit that remote learning can be a blessing in disguise for students with disabilities and could be used to their advantage.

Students with compromised mobility can avoid the challenges of travel and negotiating the confines of a school. Instead, they can design their own study space at home to accommodate their range of motion. Students who struggle socially, can avoid large classroom settings, and instead work in familiar, comfortable settings, such as at home. Communicating via forums and social media removes the pressure of interacting with others for students who are uncomfortable speaking in front of a crowd or who need time to assemble their thoughts.

Another pro is that freedom from fixed class schedules allows students with psychological or psychiatric disabilities, or post-traumatic stress disorder or cyclical mood disorders the flexibility to map study times according to fluctuations in receptivity.

Students with Asperger's syndrome and other autism spectrum disorders, or who otherwise struggle socially, can avoid large classroom settings and work in familiar, comfortable settings, such as at home. Communicating via forums and social media removes the pressure of interacting with others for students who are uncomfortable speaking in front of a crowd or who need time to assemble their thoughts.

Online programs also free students with learning disabilities like attention deficit hyperactivity disorder, known as ADHD, dyslexia, visual processing disorder, or dysgraphia from the



time pressure, stress, and aural or visual over stimulus and distractions of the traditional classroom.

Through remote learning, most parents have now become familiar with the school curriculum. Parents should help students review materials as often as needed and manipulate digital text to process information at home at their own pace.



Setting Free to Live Your Purpose

Ten years ago, I had a conversation with my older brother who told me that "You can give all the advice in the world to someone, but they must be ready to receive it." I never forgot what he said to me. Matter-of-fact, I found it so profound, I have referenced it many times since. That knowledge has stopped me from trying to save every person who I perceive needs help. I've come to understand that everyone's journey is different.

Recently I referenced my brother's advice in a conversation I had with a friend after the murder of George Floyd. I won't recount the horrific 8 minutes and 46 seconds. However, something came out of the murder that no one was prepared for; more people ready to receive conversations centered around equity, equality, diversity, cultural proficiency, and relativism.

In the aftermath of George Floyd's murder, I saw a wave of information around topics in Black America being shared on multiple digital platforms. I also noticed a wave of questions from White Americans asking how to navigate all of this new information. I had the time, space, and

energy to educate my white brothers and sisters that simply do not know how we became such a country of covert discrimination and oppression. I had an idea, prayed about it, and stepped out on faith to create a virtual course called, **Change 101: Race & Diversity Course.**

Change 101: Race & Diversity Course for White & Non-Black People seeking change.



In my professor role, it is more common to teach courses through a university or for an organization. But, this time I was stepping out on my own. I felt anxious about promoting a course strictly for white and non-black people. I thought to myself: Will my black community think I was a sell-out? Would people feel this course was some sort of reverse racism, or white bashing? What made me most anxious was freeing myself from worrying so heavily about everyone's opinion and going with what I knew God had placed in my heart to do. As I often do in moments like this, I referred back to my roots and sought the scripture. For guidance, I focused on Galatians 5:13:

13 You, my brothers, and sisters were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love.

Over the past 15 years, I have worked at Predominantly White Institutions (PWIs), observing interactions, the hidden curriculum, orientations, events, etc. I understood how much white and non-black people don't know about Black America. I understood that some don't know what it means to be Black in this country. I also knew people were ready to receive this course.


I focused on Galatians 5:13 until I released myself from the chains of fear and doubt to teach this class. Once I was free in my mind and my spirit, I went full force on putting the class together. The class ran for three weeks, with all the curriculum components of my typical courses including pre- and post-class surveys, action assignments, access to a Dropbox folder, and videos of each lecture for those who missed a week.

The support was overwhelming and the number of people who registered confirmed I had made the right decision. Since then, I have repeated it (or parts of it) to other institutions and organizations.

Too often we limit ourselves with the weight of anxiety, doubt, or fear. Setting yourself free is necessary for you to give the world what you were purposed to give. Your contribution to humanity is important. If you are looking for motivation in song for setting yourself free, take a listen to *Hillsong United*, "Yes I am", or *Myron Butler*, Set me Free.

I know the feeling of being chained downed by emotional, psychological, and spiritual fears. Feeling as if the majority of people are against you can require an overwhelming majority of positive force on our side. For anyone with those feelings, remember that You + God equals a Majority. Set yourself free from whatever is weighing you down and live out your purpose.
